


Workers' Compensation Claim Process at a Glance



** IMPORTANT TIME LIMITS **

You have 6 months to lodge a workers' compensation claim from the date your doctor diagnosed you and attributed your injury to your employment.

If your claim is rejected, you have 3 months to lodge a review with the Workers' Compensation Regulator, from the date you receive notice of the decision.

If the Regulator also rejects your claim, you have 20 business days to lodge an Appeal with the Queensland Industrial Relations Commission.

Extensions may be granted in certain circumstances, however legal advice is recommended.
