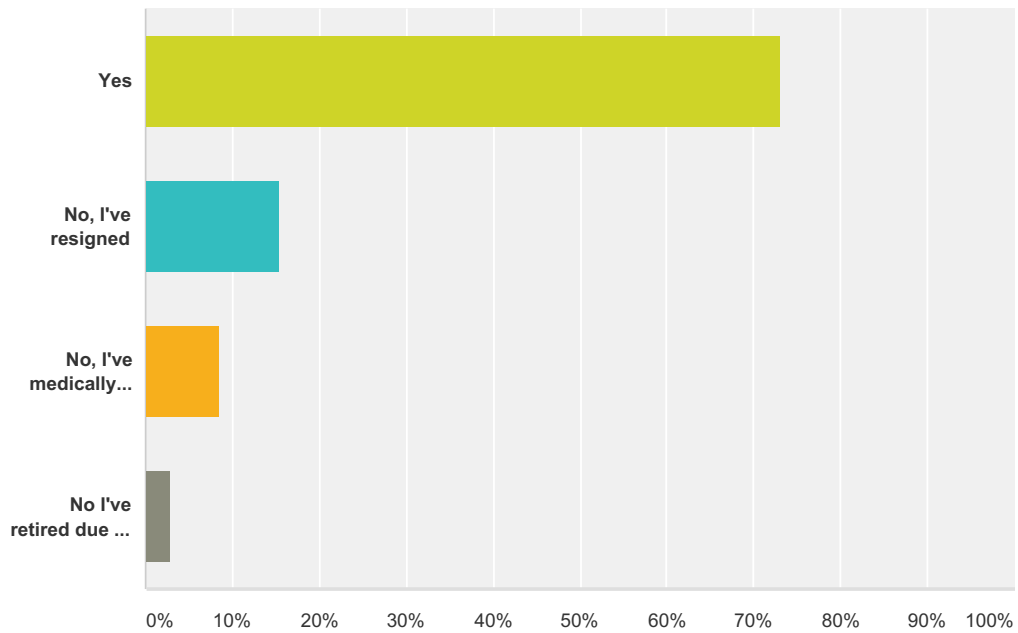


Q1 Are you a current serving Queensland Police Officer?

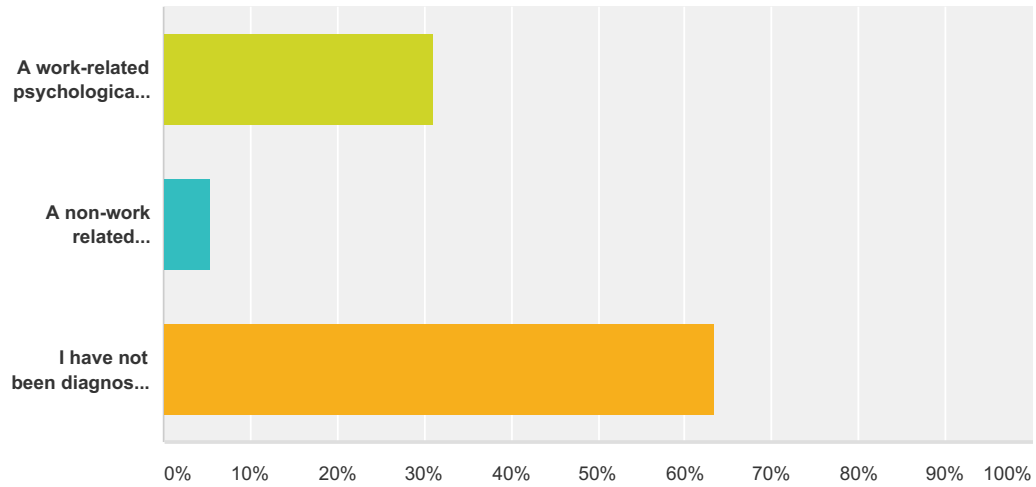

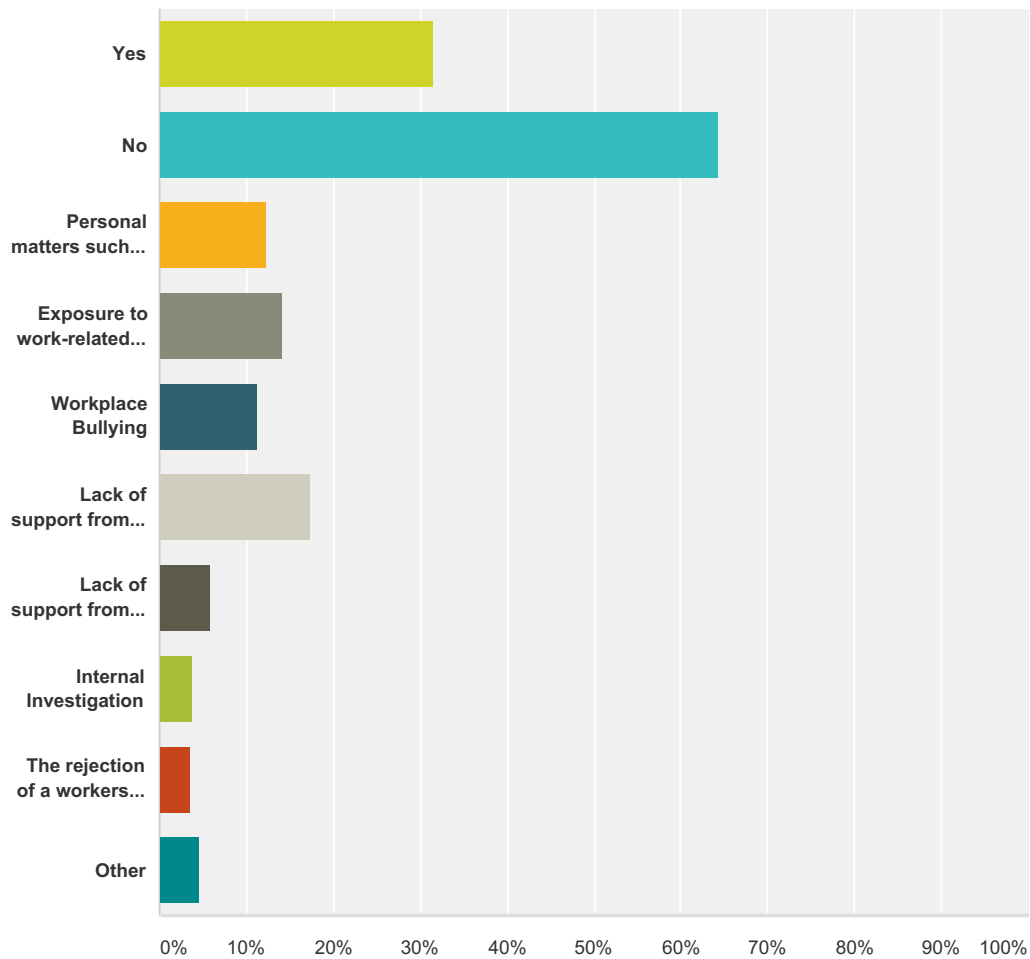

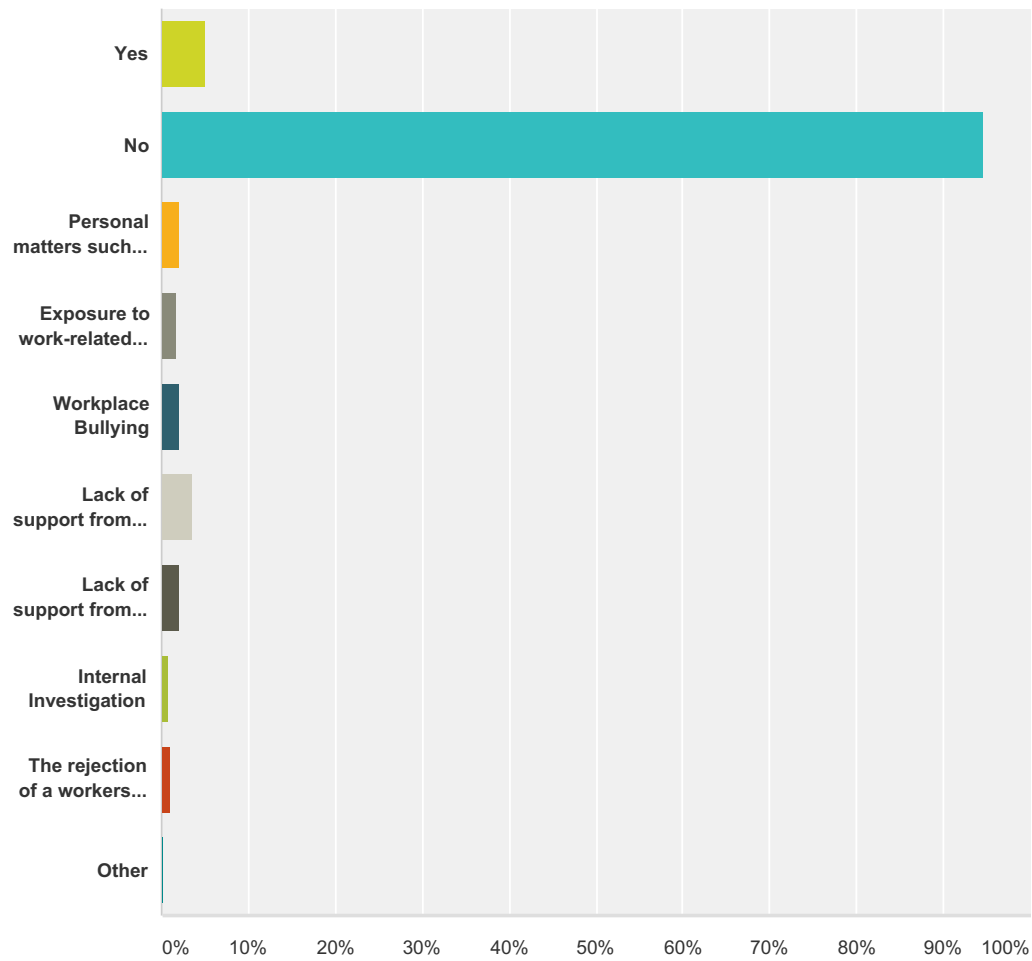

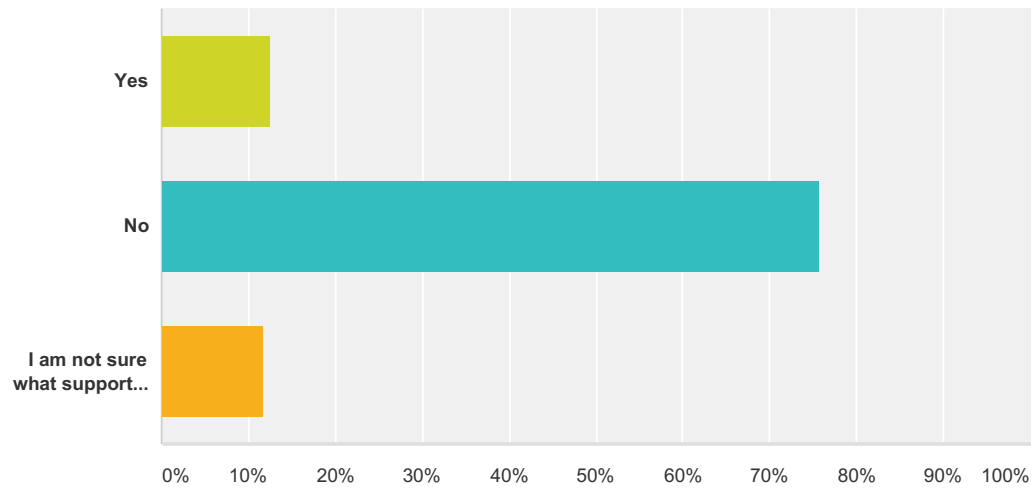

Q5 Do you believe the QPS has enough psychological support systems in place?

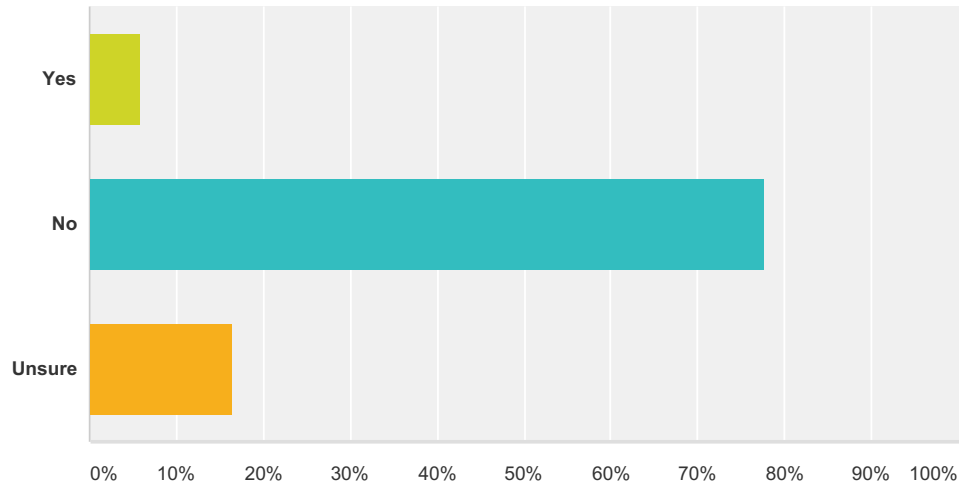

Q6 Do you feel that members of Queensland Police Management are supportive of workers who sustain psychological injuries?

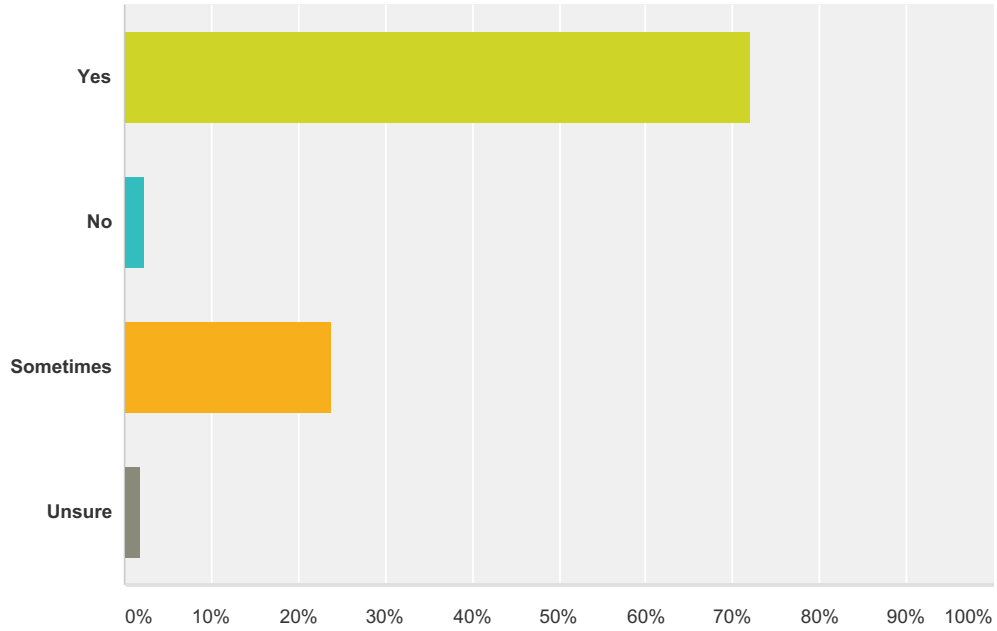

Q7 Generally speaking, is there a negative stigma attached to officers who admit to having mental health problems?

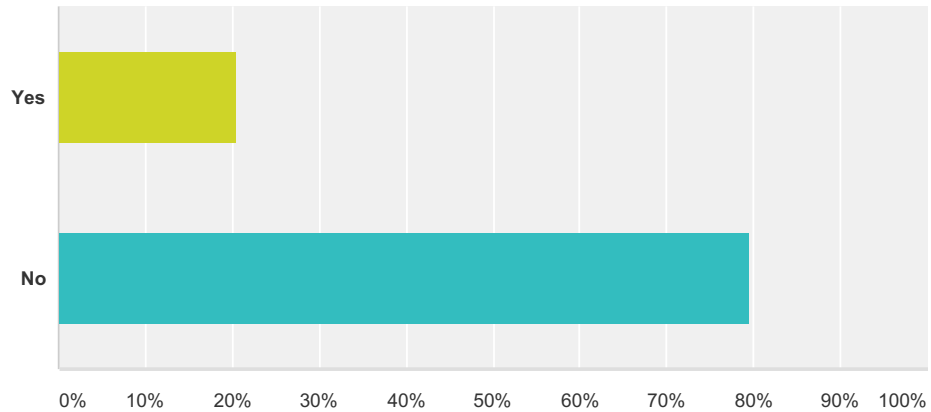

Q8 If you were to experience depression, PTSD or another stress related psychological injury today, would you feel comfortable advising your superior officers? If 'NO', why not?

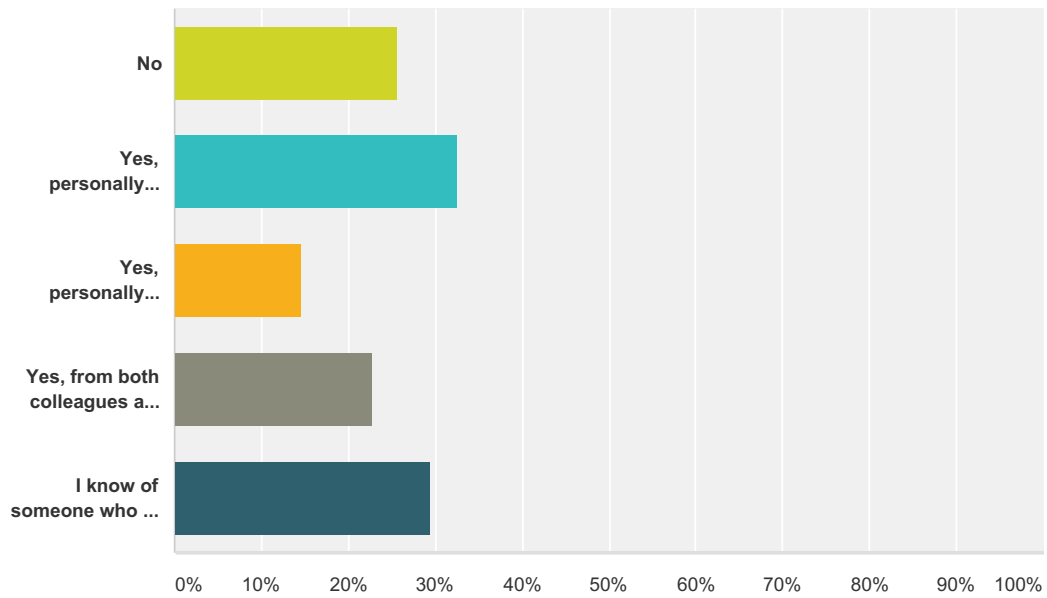

Q9 Have you experienced workplace bullying within the QPS?

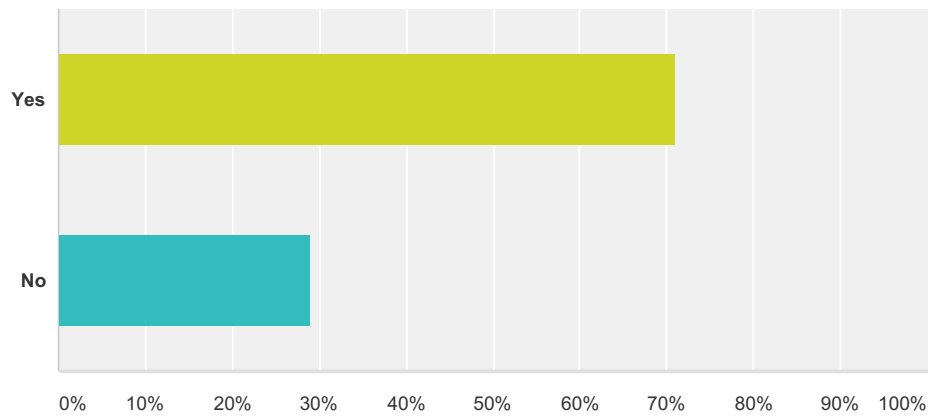
